- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Crown Jewel National
- 5 Parks Act".

#### 1 SEC. 2. PRIORITY FUNDING REQUESTS FOR NATIONAL

- PARKS.
- 3 Section 1105(a) of title 31, United States Code, is
- 4 amended by adding at the end the following:
- 5 "(32) a separate statement of the amount of
- 6 appropriations requested for priority funding for
- 7 each national park, the Crown Jewels of the Na-
- 8 tional Park System, and a separate statement set-
- 9 ting forth the reasons why priority funding is not re-
- quested for a national park (if any).".
