A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Navy to terminate the operation of the Extremely Low Frequency Communications System of the Navy.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Extremely Low Fre-
- 5 quency Communications System Termination Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF NAVY'S EXTREMELY LOW FRE-
- 7 QUENCY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM.
- 8 Not later than 30 days after the date of the enact-
- 9 ment of this Act, the Secretary of the Navy shall terminate

- 1 all operations of the communications system of the Navy
- $2\,$ known as the Extremely Low Frequency (ELF) system.
