## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to make health insurance costs fully deductible for the self-employed.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FULL DEDUCTIBILITY OF HEALTH INSURANCE
- 4 COSTS FOR SELF-EMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS.
- 5 (a) In General.—Paragraph (1) of section 162(l)
- 6 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to special
- 7 rules for health insurance costs of self-employed individ-
- 8 uals) is amended to read as follows:
- 9 "(1) Allowance of Deduction.—In the case
- of an individual who is an employee within the

- 1 meaning of section 401(c)(1), there shall be allowed
- 2 as a deduction under this section an amount equal
- 3 to the amount paid during the taxable year for in-
- 4 surance which constitutes medical care for the tax-
- 5 payer, his spouse, and dependents."
- 6 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 7 subsection (a) shall apply to taxable years beginning after
- 8 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
