## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to transfer certain Fort Howard Park lands to Baltimore County, Maryland.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. LAND TRANSFER AT FORT HOWARD PARK, BAL-
- 4 TIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND.
- 5 (a) In General.—Except as provided by subsection
- 6 (c), the Secretary of Veterans Affairs may transfer, with-
- 7 out consideration, all right, title, and interest of the
- 8 United States in and to the lands described in subsection
- 9 (b) to Baltimore County, Maryland, for use for public pur-
- 10 poses.

1 (b) Lands Described.—The lands referred to in subsection (a) are those parcels located at the Fort Howard Division of the Veterans Administration Maryland 3 Health Care System which consist of approximately 35 acres and are labelled as "Parcel A" and "Parcel B" on the map entitled "Fort Howard Park Land Transfer" and dated . The exact acreage and legal description of the real property to be transferred under this section 8 shall be determined by a survey satisfactory to the Sec-10 retary of Veterans Affairs. 11 (c) REVERSION.—Any lands transferred under sub-12 section (a) that cease to be used for public purposes by
