A BILL

To provide off-budget treatment for one-half of the receipts and disbursements of the land and water conservation fund, and to provide that the amount appropriated from the fund for a fiscal year for Federal purposes may not exceed the amount appropriated for that fiscal year for financial assistance to the States for State purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. OFF-BUDGET TREATMENT FOR ONE-HALF OF**
2 **THE RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS OF THE**
3 **LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law except
5 the Line Item Veto Act of 1996, one-half of the receipts
6 and disbursements of the land and water conservation
7 fund—

8 (1) shall not be counted as new budget author-
9 ity, outlays, receipts, or deficit or surplus for pur-
10 poses of—

11 (A) the budget of the United States Gov-
12 ernment as submitted by the President,

13 (B) the congressional budget (including al-
14 locations of budget authority and outlays pro-
15 vided therein), or

16 (C) the Balanced Budget and Emergency
17 Deficit Control Act of 1985; and

18 (2) shall be exempt from any general budget
19 limitation imposed by statute on expenditures and
20 net lending (budget outlays) of the United States
21 Government.

1 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ANNUAL USE OF LAND AND WATER**
2 **CONSERVATION FUND FOR FEDERAL PUR-**
3 **POSES.**

4 Section 7 of the Land and Water Conservation Fund
5 Act (16 U.S.C. 460l–9) is amended by adding at the end
6 the following new subsection:

7 “(c) LIMITATION ON APPROPRIATIONS.—The amount
8 appropriated from the fund for a fiscal year for Federal
9 purposes under this or any other Federal law may not ex-
10 ceed the amount appropriated for that fiscal year for fi-
11 nancial assistance to the States for State purposes under
12 section 6.”.
