Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. CATEGORY OF NONCOUNTERVAILABLE SUBSIDY.

Section 771(5B) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C.

1677(5B)) is amended by inserting after subparagraph

(G) the following:

"(H) TIMBER SUPPLY MEASURES.—Pric-

ing practices or tenure arrangements for the

sale of softwood timber grown on publicly owned lands and log export restrictions shall be treated as noncountervailable.".
