A BILL

To schedule Gamma y-hydroxybutyrate in schedule I of the Controlled Substances Act and to schedule Ketamine in schedule II of such Act and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hillory J. Farias Date
5 Rape Prevention Drug Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DRUG SCHEDULING.**

2 The Attorney General shall schedule Gamma y-
3 hydroxybutyrate in schedule I of the Controlled Sub-
4 stances Act (21 U.S.C. 812) and shall schedule Ketamine
5 in schedule II of such Act.

6 **SEC. 3. EDUCATION AND DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION.**

7 The Attorney General shall establish programs
8 throughout the United States and disseminate materials
9 to provide young people in high school and college with
10 education about the use of controlled substances in the
11 furtherance of rape and sexual assault and shall assist law
12 enforcement personnel in the prevention of abuse of con-
13 trolled substances for such purpose.
