A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Hillory J. Farias Date
- 5 Rape Prevention Drug Act".

1 SEC. 2. DRUG SCHEDULING.

- 2 The Attorney General shall schedule Gamma y-
- 3 hydroxybutyrate in schedule I of the Controlled Sub-
- 4 stances Act (21 U.S.C. 812) and shall schedule Ketamine
- 5 in schedule II of such Act.

6 SEC. 3. EDUCATION AND DRUG ABUSE PREVENTION.

- 7 The Attorney General shall establish programs
- 8 throughout the United States and disseminate materials
- 9 to provide young people in high school and college with
- 10 education about the use of controlled substances in the
- 11 furtherance of rape and sexual assault and shall assist law
- 12 enforcement personnel in the prevention of abuse of con-
- 13 trolled substances for such purpose.
