A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to reduce the size of grand juries.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Grand Jury Reduction
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF SIZE OF GRAND JURIES.
- 7 Section 3321 of title 18, United States Code, is
- 8 amended to read as follows:

1 "§ 3321. Number of grand jurors; summoning addi-

2 tional jurors

- 3 "(a) Every grand jury impaneled before any district
- 4 court shall consist of not less than 9 nor more than 13
- 5 persons. If less than 9 of the persons summoned attend,
- 6 they shall be placed on the grand jury and the court shall
- 7 order that an additional number of persons be summoned
- 8 to complete the grand jury in a manner ordered by the
- 9 court in accordance with procedures set forth in section
- 10 1866 of title 28. Whenever a challenge to a grand juror
- 11 is allowed, and there not in attendance others jurors suffi-
- 12 cient to complete the grand jury, the court shall make a
- 13 like order.
- 14 "(b) An indictment may be found only if at least 9
- 15 jurors are present and 7 of those present concur.".
