A BILL

To establish a limitation on the vessels that may engage in harvesting Atlantic mackerel or Atlantic herring within the exclusive economic zone.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON VESSELS THAT MAY ENGAGE
- 4 IN ATLANTIC MACKEREL AND ATLANTIC HER-
- 5 RING FISHING WITHIN EEZ.
- 6 Notwithstanding any provision of the Magnuson-Ste-
- 7 vens Fishery Conservation and Management Act (16
- 8 U.S.C. 1801 et seq.), a vessel of the United States may
- 9 engage in harvesting Atlantic mackerel or Atlantic herring
- 10 within the exclusive economic zone only if the vessel—

1 (1) had, before April 1, 1997, a documented 2 landing in a port on the East Coast of the United 3 States of at least one pound of fish harvested under 4 a fishing permit issued under Federal or State law; 5 or 6 (2) is not more than 165 feet in overall length

(2) is not more than 165 feet in overall length and has engines that produce a total of not more than 3,000 horsepower.
