- 3 Subsection (c) of section 1106 of the Social Security
- 4 Act is amended to read as follows:
- 5 "(c) Notwithstanding sections 552 and 552a of title
- 6 5, United States Code, or any other provision of law,
- 7 whenever the Secretary determines—
- 8 "(1) that a request for any type of information
- 9 is made in order to assist a party in interest (as de-
- fined in section 3 of the Employee Retirement In-
- 11 come Security Act of 1974 (29 U.S.C. 102)) with re-
- spect to the administration of an employee benefit
- plan (as so defined) and that information of such
- type has previously been provided by the Secretary
- pursuant to a request made in order to so assist
- such party in interest, or
- 17 "(2) that a request for information is made for
- any purpose (other than a purpose described in
- paragraph (1)) which is not directly related to the
- administration of the program or programs under
- 21 this Act to which such information relates,
- 22 the Secretary may require the requestor to pay the full
- 23 cost, as determined by the Secretary, of providing such
- 24 information.".
