A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, relating to the Interstate 4–R discretionary program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Highway Restoration
5 Act of 1997”.

6 **SEC. 2. PERIOD OF AVAILABILITY.**

7 Section 118(c)(2)(A) of title 23, United States Code,
8 is amended—

1 (1) by striking “\$54,000,000 for fiscal year
2 1992, \$64,000,000 for each of fiscal years 1993,
3 1994, 1995, and 1996, and \$65,000,000 for fiscal
4 year 1997” and inserting “\$800,000,000 per fiscal
5 year”;

6 (2) by striking “any highway designated as a
7 part of the Interstate System under section 139
8 and”;

9 (3) by striking “Of the amounts set aside under
10 the preceding sentence, the Secretary shall obligate
11 \$16,000,000 for fiscal year 1992 and \$17,000,000
12 for each of fiscal years 1993 and 1994 for improve-
13 ments on the Kennedy Expressway in Chicago, Illi-
14 nois.”; and

15 (4) by striking “The remainder of such” and
16 inserting “Such”.
