Mr. SPRATT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Air Force to conduct a study to identify Air Force property suitable for exchange to acquire land authorized for addition to Shaw Air Force Base in the State of South Carolina.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STUDY OF LAND EXCHANGE OPTIONS, SHAW**
4 **AIR FORCE BASE, SOUTH CAROLINA.**

5 Section 2874 of the National Defense Authorization
6 Act for Fiscal Year 1996 (Public Law 104–106; 110 Stat.
7 583) is amended by adding at the end the following new
8 subsection:

1 “(g) STUDY OF EXCHANGE OPTIONS.—To facilitate
2 the use of a land exchange to acquire the real property
3 described in subsection (a), the Secretary of the Air Force
4 shall conduct a study to identify real property in the pos-
5 session of the Air Force (located in the State of South
6 Carolina or elsewhere) that satisfies the requirements of
7 subsection (b)(2), is acceptable to the party holding the
8 property to be acquired, and is otherwise suitable for ex-
9 change under this section. Not later than three months
10 after the date of the enactment of this subsection, the Sec-
11 retary shall submit to Congress a report containing the
12 results of the study.”.
