## A BILL

To require the Secretary of the Air Force to conduct a study to identify Air Force property suitable for exchange to acquire land authorized for addition to Shaw Air Force Base in the State of South Carolina.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. STUDY OF LAND EXCHANGE OPTIONS, SHAW
- 4 AIR FORCE BASE, SOUTH CAROLINA.
- 5 Section 2874 of the National Defense Authorization
- 6 Act for Fiscal Year 1996 (Public Law 104–106; 110 Stat.
- 7 583) is amended by adding at the end the following new
- 8 subsection:

- 1 "(g) STUDY OF EXCHANGE OPTIONS.—To facilitate 2 the use of a land exchange to acquire the real property
- 3 described in subsection (a), the Secretary of the Air Force
- 4 shall conduct a study to identify real property in the pos-
- 5 session of the Air Force (located in the State of South
- 6 Carolina or elsewhere) that satisfies the requirements of
- 7 subsection (b)(2), is acceptable to the party holding the
- 8 property to be acquired, and is otherwise suitable for ex-
- 9 change under this section. Not later than three months
- 10 after the date of the enactment of this subsection, the Sec-
- 11 retary shall submit to Congress a report containing the
- 12 results of the study.".
