- 5 (a) Receipt of Fair Market Value.—Subsection
- 6 (b)(4) of section 2667 of title 10, United States Code, is

- 1 amended by striking out ", in the case of the lease of real
- 2 property,".
- 3 (b) Competitive Selection.—Such section is fur-
- 4 ther amended—
- 5 (1) by redesignating subsection (g) as sub-
- 6 section (h); and
- 7 (2) by inserting after subsection (f) the follow-
- 8 ing new subsection:
- 9 "(g) If a proposed lease under subsection (a) involves
- 10 only personal property, the lease term exceeds one year,
- 11 and the fair market value of the lease interest exceeds
- 12 \$100,000, as determined by the Secretary concerned, the
- 13 Secretary shall use competitive procedures to select the
- 14 lessee.".
