A BILL

For the relief of Lieutenant Colonel (retired) Robert L. Stockwell, United States Army.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PAYMENT FOR SERVICE AND RELATED EX-
- 4 PENSES.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Out of any money in the Treasury
- 6 not otherwise appropriated, the Secretary of the Treasury
- 7 shall pay to Lieutenant Colonel (retired) Robert L. Stock-
- 8 well, United States Army, of Overland Park, Kansas,
- 9 \$40,665 as payment for services (while in a retired status)
- 10 as Program Manager of the Private Office Independent

- 1 Outreach Program in Brussels, Belgium, during 1993 and
- 2 1994. For purposes of section 911 of the Internal Revenue
- 3 Code of 1986, such payment shall be treated as foreign
- 4 earned income within the meaning of such section.
- 5 (b) Payment for Moving and Interest Ex-
- 6 PENSES.—In addition to the payment provided for in sub-
- 7 section (a), out of any money in the Treasury not other-
- 8 wise appropriated, the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay
- 9 to Lieutenant Colonel Stockwell—
- 10 (1) \$21,838 for moving expenses incurred by
- 11 Lieutenant Colonel Stockwell in conjunction with
- holding such position; and
- 13 (2) \$10,000 for interest expenses incurred by
- 14 Lieutenant Colonel Stockwell in conjunction with
- 15 holding such position.
- 16 SEC. 2. WAIVER OF PAYMENT FOR TUITION.
- 17 Any liability of Lieutenant Colonel (retired) Robert
- 18 L. Stockwell to the United States for tuition for his chil-
- 19 dren to attend school while he was performing the service
- 20 described in section 1 is hereby extinguished.
