- 6 SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF NEW PRODUCTION OF TRIDENT II
- 7 (D-5) MISSILES.
- 8 (a) Production Termination.—Funds appro-
- 9 priated for the Department of Defense for fiscal years
- 10 after fiscal year 1997 may not be obligated or expended

- 1 to commence production of additional Trident II (D-5)
- 2 missiles.
- 3 (b) Authorized Scope of Trident II (D-5) Pro-
- 4 GRAM.—Amounts appropriated for the Department of De-
- 5 fense may be expended for the Trident II (D-5) missile
- 6 program only for the completion of production of those
- 7 Trident II (D-5) missiles which were commenced with
- 8 funds appropriated for a fiscal year before fiscal year
- 9 1998.
