- 3 That notwithstanding section 201 or subsection (a) or (b)
- 4 of section 202 of the Controlled Substances Act (21
- 5 U.S.C. 811, 812(a), 812(b)) respecting the scheduling of
- 6 controlled substances, the Attorney General shall, by order

- 1 add ketamine hydrochloride and gamma hydroxybutyrate
- 2 to schedule III of such Act.
