## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, with respect to the penalty for the rape of juveniles in prison.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Juvenile Rape in Pris-
- 5 on Protection Act of 1997".
- 6 SEC. 2. PENALTY FOR RAPE OF JUVENILES IN PRISON.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 109A of title 18, United
- 8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the follow-
- 9 ing:

### 1 "§ 2249. Penalty for rape of juveniles in prison

- 2 "Whoever, having attained the age of 21 years, vio-
- 3 lates section 2241 shall, if the victim is a Federal prisoner
- 4 who has not attained the age of 18 years, be sentenced
- 5 to life in prison.".
- 6 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
- 7 at the beginning of chapter 109A of title 18, United States
- 8 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new
- 9 item:

"2249. Penalty for rape of juveniles in prison.".
