1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. PAYMENT FOR LEASE OF HOTEL.
4	Out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise ap-
5	propriated, the Secretary of the Treasury shall pay to Mr.
6	Guy Lau and Ms. Chantal Lau Pease, the son and daugh-
7	ter of Mr. Lau Tsang (to be divided equally between
8	them)—
9	(1) the sum of \$393,115; and
10	(2) interest on such sum for the period begin-

ning on June 31, 1971, and ending on the date of

the enactment of this Act (calculated at the average

- 1 rate offered by depository institutions to their best
- 2 business customers as published in the Wall Street
- 3 Journal);
- 4 as payment for the lease by Mr. Lau Tsang of the Capitol
- 5 Hotel in Saigon, Vietnam, from August, 1969, until June,
- 6 1971, to the United States Armed Forces. The payment
- 7 of this sum shall be in full satisfaction of any claim
- 8 against the United States for payment for such lease.

9 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEY'S AND AGENT'S FEES.

- Not more than 10 percent of the sum appropriated
- 11 by section 1 shall be paid to or received by any agent or
- 12 attorney for services rendered in connection with the claim
- 13 described in such section. Any person who violates the pro-
- 14 visions of this section shall be fined not more than
- 15 \$10,000.
