To amend title 18 of the United States Code to penalize the rape of minors in Federal prisons.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Juvenile Rape in Pris-
- 5 on Protection Act of 1997".

1 SEC. 2. JUVENILE RAPE IN PRISON.

- 2 Section 2241(a) of title 18, United States Code, is
- 3 amended—
- 4 (1) by inserting "(1)" before "Whoever";
- 5 (2) by striking "(1)" and inserting "(A)";
- 6 (3) by striking "(2)" and inserting "(B)"; and
- 7 (4) by adding the following new paragraphs:
- 8 "(2) Whoever, having attained the age of 21 years,
- 9 violates paragraph (1) of this subsection or subsection (b)
- 10 in a Federal prison shall, except in the case of an attempt,
- 11 if the victim has not attained the age of 18 years, be im-
- 12 prisoned for life.
- 13 "(3) It is an affirmative defense to a prosecution
- 14 under paragraph (2) of this subsection, which the defend-
- 15 ant must establish by a preponderance of the evidence,
- 16 that the defendant reasonably believed that the victim had
- 17 attained the age of 18 years.".
