## A BILL

To prohibit the shipment of spent nuclear fuel to the Goshute Indian reservation in Utah.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHIPMENT OF SPENT NUCLEAR FUEL.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—A shipment of spent nuclear fuel  
5 in interstate commerce to the Goshute Indian reservation  
6 in Utah shall be considered a shipment of a hazardous  
7 material in violation of the requirements of chapter 51 of  
8 title 49, United States Code, and a person who makes  
9 such a shipment shall be subject to the penalties pre-  
10 scribed by sections 5123 and 5124 of such title.

1 (b) PENALTIES.—For purposes of chapter 51 of title  
2 49, United States Code—

3 (1) each day a shipment described in subsection  
4 (a) is made shall be considered a separate violation  
5 of such chapter;

6 (2) each cask of spent nuclear fuel contained in  
7 such shipment shall be considered a separate viola-  
8 tion of such chapter; and

9 (3) a civil penalty of \$25,000 under section  
10 5123 of such title shall be set for each violation de-  
11 scribed in this section.
