1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ADDITIONS TO APPALACHIAN REGION.**

4       Section 403 of the Appalachian Regional Develop-  
5       ment Act of 1965 (40 U.S.C. App.) is amended in the  
6       undesignated paragraph relating to Georgia—

7               (1) by inserting “Elbert,” after “Douglas,”;  
8       and

9               (2) by inserting “Hart,” after “Haralson.”.
