## A BILL

To reduce the amounts allocated for payments pursuant to production flexibility contracts entered into under the Agricultural Market Transition Act.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. REDUCTION IN AMOUNTS PAYABLE UNDER**  
4       **PRODUCTION FLEXIBILITY CONTRACTS.**

5       The amounts specified in paragraphs (2) through (7)  
6       of section 113(a) of the Agricultural Market Transition  
7       Act (7 U.S.C. 7213(a)) for payments to farmers pursuant  
8       to production flexibility contracts shall be reduced by five  
9       percent for each of the fiscal years 1997 through 2002.
