1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. VOLUNTARY COMPLIANCE BY STATES WITH NA-
4	TIONAL VOTER REGISTRATION ACT OF 1993.
5	(a) In General.—The National Voter Registration
6	Act of 1993 (42 U.S.C. 1973gg et seq.) is amended—
7	(1) by redesignating section 13 as section 14;
8	and
9	(2) by inserting after section 12 the following
10	new section:

1 "SEC. 13. VOLUNTARY COMPLIANCE BY STATES.

- 2 "Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act,
- 3 compliance by a State with any provision of this Act shall
- 4 be voluntary.".
- 5 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 6 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-
- 7 ment of this Act.
