A BILL

To designate the post office located at 194 Ward Street, in Paterson, New Jersey, as the "Larry Doby Post Office".

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3 SECTION 1. FINDINGS.
4 Congress finds the following:
5 (1) Larry Eugene Doby was born in Camden,
6 South Carolina, on December 12, 1923, and moved
7 to Paterson, New Jersey, in 1938.
8 (2) After playing the 1946 season in the Negro

League for the Newark Eagles, Larry Doby's con-

- tract was purchased by the Cleveland Indians of the
 American League on July 3, 1947.
- 3 (3) On July 5, 1947, Larry Doby became the 4 first African-American to play in the American 5 League.
 - (4) Larry Doby played in the American League for 13 years, appearing in 1,533 games and batting .283, with 253 home runs and 969 runs batted in.
 - (5) Larry Doby was voted to 7 all-star teams, led the American League in home runs twice, and played in 2 World Series; he was the first African-American to play in the World Series and to hit a home run in a World Series game, both in 1948.
- 14 (6) After his stellar playing career ended, Larry
 15 Doby continued to make a significant contribution to
 16 his community; he has been a pioneer in the cause
 17 of civil rights and has received honorary doctorate
 18 degrees from Long Island University, Princeton Uni19 versity, and Fairfield University.
