- 3 SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF COUNTY.

- 6 (1) in subsection (a) by striking "Philadelphia,
- 7 and Schuylkill" and inserting "and Philadelphia";
- 8 and

- 1 (2) in subsection (b) by inserting "Schuylkill,"
- 2 after "Potter,".

3 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—This Act and the amendments
- 5 made by this Act shall take effect 180 days after the date
- 6 of the enactment of this Act.
- 7 (b) Pending Cases Not Affected.—This Act and
- 8 the amendments made by this Act shall not affect any ac-
- 9 tion commenced before the effective date of this Act and
- 10 pending on such date in the United States District Court
- 11 for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania.
- 12 (c) Juries Not Affected.—This Act and the
- 13 amendments made by this Act shall not affect the com-
- 14 position, or preclude the service, of any grand or petit jury
- 15 summoned, impaneled, or actually serving on the effective
- 16 date of this Act.
