A BILL

- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SPECIAL USE PERMIT, HUMBOLDT NURSERY,
- 4 SIX RIVERS NATIONAL FOREST, CALIFORNIA.
- 5 Section 7 of the Act of April 24, 1950 (7 U.S.C.
- 6 580d; commonly known as the Granger-Thye Act) is
- 7 amended by adding at the end the following: "In the case
- 8 of Humboldt Nursery, Six Rivers National Forest, Califor-

- 1 nia, which is scheduled to cease operations as a Forest
- 2 Service nursery in 1999, a permit under this section may
- 3 include a provision allowing the permittee to use Govern-
- 4 ment-owned farming and related equipment at the Nurs-
- 5 ery, subject to the maintenance and reconditioning re-
- 6 quirements of the preceding proviso.".
