## A BILL

To amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to ensure that teachers receive technology training.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. TEACHER TECHNOLOGY TRAINING.
- 4 Section 3135(b) of the Elementary and Secondary
- 5 Education Act of 1965 is amended to read as follows:
- 6 "(b) Use of Funds.—
- 7 "(1) Reservations.—Not less than 20 percent
- 8 of the amounts awarded pursuant to subsection (a)
- 9 shall be used to train teachers and librarians to en-
- sure a level of proficiency in the use of technology.

1 "(2) GENERAL USE.—The remaining amounts 2 available under this section shall be used for activi-3 ties similar to the activities described in section 4 3134.".
