A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain other single
viscose rayon yarn.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902. .	Other yarn, single: Of viscose rayon, untwisted or with a twist not exceeding 120 turns/m (provided for in subheading 5403.31.00), except for medium tenacity rayon filament yarn (2.8 to 4.1 grains per denier) manufactured solely for the purpose of carbonizing ..	7.5%	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/1998	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
