## A BILL

To amend the Crime Control Act of 1990 to require reporting of child abuse by electronic communication service providers.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Child Abuse Notifica-
- 5 tion Act of 1997".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPORTING OF CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE BY ELEC-
- 7 TRONIC COMMUNICATION SERVICE PROVID-
- 8 ERS.
- 9 (a) In General.—Section 226(a) of the Crime Con-
- 10 trol Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 13031(a)) is amended—

1	(1) by inserting "(1)" before "A person"; and
2	(2) by adding at the end the following:
3	"(2) A person who, while engaged in providing an
4	electronic communication service or a remote computing
5	service to the public, learns of such facts through an inter-
6	state or foreign transaction or through a facility or means
7	of interstate or foreign commerce, if the incident is an in-
8	cident of sexual abuse, shall as soon as reasonably possible
9	make such a report.".
10	(b) Section 2702(b)(6) of title 18, United States
11	Code, is amended to read as follows:
12	"(6) to a law enforcement agency—
13	"(A) if such contents—
14	"(i) were inadvertently obtained by
15	the service provider; and
16	"(ii) appear to pertain to the commis-
17	sion of a crime; or
18	"(B) if required by section 226(a)(2) of
19	the Crime Control Act of 1990.".
