A BILL

To amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to increase the Federal minimum wage.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "American Family Fair
- 5 Minimum Wage Act of 1997".
- 6 SEC. 2. MINIMUM WAGE INCREASE.
- 7 Paragraph (1) of section 6(a) of the Fair Labor
- 8 Standards Act of 1938 (29 U.S.C. 206(a)(1)) is amended
- 9 to read as follows:

1	"(1) except as otherwise provided in this sec-
2	tion, not less than—
3	"(A) \$5.65 an hour during the year begin-
4	ning on September 1, 1998;
5	"(B) \$6.15 an hour during the year begin-
6	ning on September 1, 1999;
7	"(C) \$6.65 an hour during the year begin-
8	ning on September 1, 2000;
9	"(D) \$6.95 an hour during the year begin-
10	ning on September 1, 2001; and
11	"(E) \$7.25 an hour during the year begin-
12	ning on September 1, 2002.".
