- 3 SECTION 1. DENIAL OF PAY ADJUSTMENT FOR MEMBERS
- 4 OF CONGRESS.
- 5 For purposes of the provision of law amended by sub-
- 6 paragraph (B) of section 704(a)(2) of the Ethics Reform
- 7 Act of 1989 (5 U.S.C. 5318 note), relating to compensa-
- 8 tion of Members of Congress, no adjustment under section
- 9 5303 of title 5, United States Code, shall be considered

- 1 to have taken effect in fiscal year 1998 in the rates of
- $2\;$ basic pay for the statutory pay systems.
