To amend section 1584 of title 18, United States Code, to clarify that forcing immigrants into slave labor by withholding immigration documents, or by threatening to involve immigration authorities, is a violation of such section.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This act may be cited as the "Immigrant Slave Trade
- 5 Punishment Act of 1997".

1 SEC. 2. INVOLUNTARY SERVITUDE.

- 2 Section 1584 of title 18, United States Code, is
- 3 amended—
- 4 (1) by inserting "(a)" before "Whoever";
- 5 (2) by inserting at the end the following:
- 6 "(b) Whoever for pecuniary gain violates subsection
- 7 (a) with respect to five or more persons shall be impris-
- 8 oned for not less than 20 years or for life.
- 9 "(c) For purposes of this section, the term "involun-
- 10 tary servitude" includes any circumstance under which
- 11 any legal or illegal immigrant is coerced to work through
- 12 withholding of the immigrant's immigration documents, or
- 13 through threatening to report an illegal immigrant to the
- 14 authorities."; and
- 15 (3) in the heading by striking "**Sale into involun-**
- 16 tary", and inserting "Involuntary".
- 17 SEC. 3. CLERICAL AMENDMENT.
- The table of sections for chapter 77 of title 18,
- 19 United States Code, is amended in the matter relating to
- 20 section 1584 by striking "Sale into involuntary" and in-
- 21 serting "Involuntary".
