- 4 PAYER RELIEF ACT OF 1997 TO AIRLINE TICK-
- 5 ET TAXES.
- 6 Subsection (c) of section 1031 of the Taxpayer Relief
- 7 Act of 1997 (relating to modifications to tax on transpor-
- 8 tation of persons by air), and the amendments made by

- 1 such section, are hereby repealed; and the Internal Reve-
- 2 nue Code of 1986 shall be applied as if such subsection

3 and amendments had never been enacted.
