## A BILL

To authorize certain uses of water from the Solano Project, California.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SOLANO PROJECT WATER.
- 4 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary of the Interior
- 5 is authorized to enter into contracts with the Solano Coun-
- 6 ty Water Agency, or any of its member unit contractors
- 7 for water from the Solano Project, California, pursuant
- 8 to the Act of February 21, 1911 (43 U.S.C. 523), for—
- 9 (1) the impounding, storage, and carriage of
- 10 nonproject water for domestic, municipal, industrial,

- 1 and other beneficial purposes, using any facilities as-2 sociated with the Solano Project, California, and
- 3 the exchange of water among Solano 4 Project contractors, for the purposes set forth in 5 paragraph (1), using facilities associated with the 6
- Solano Project, California.
- 7 (b) LIMITATION.—The authorization under sub-
- section (a) shall be limited to the use of that portion of 8
- the Solano Project facilities downstream of Mile 26 of the
- 10 Putah South Canal as depicted on the official maps of the
- Bureau of Reclamation, and to that portion of the Solano
- Project facilities below the diversion points on the Putah
- South Canal utilized by the city of Fairfield for delivery
- of Solano Project water. 14
