Mr. MILLER of California introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To authorize certain uses of water from the Solano Project, California.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SOLANO PROJECT WATER.**

4 (a) AUTHORIZATION.—The Secretary of the Interior
5 is authorized to enter into contracts with the Solano Coun-
6 ty Water Agency, or any of its member unit contractors
7 for water from the Solano Project, California, pursuant
8 to the Act of February 21, 1911 (43 U.S.C. 523), for—

9 (1) the impounding, storage, and carriage of
10 nonproject water for domestic, municipal, industrial,

1 and other beneficial purposes, using any facilities as-
2 sociated with the Solano Project, California, and

3 (2) the exchange of water among Solano
4 Project contractors, for the purposes set forth in
5 paragraph (1), using facilities associated with the
6 Solano Project, California.

7 (b) LIMITATION.—The authorization under sub-
8 section (a) shall be limited to the use of that portion of
9 the Solano Project facilities downstream of Mile 26 of the
10 Putah South Canal as depicted on the official maps of the
11 Bureau of Reclamation, and to that portion of the Solano
12 Project facilities below the diversion points on the Putah
13 South Canal utilized by the city of Fairfield for delivery
14 of Solano Project water.
