## A BILL

To amend the National Trails System Act to require local approval of designations of railroad rights-of-way for interim use as trails.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. LOCAL APPROVAL OF TRAIL DESIGNATIONS.
- 4 Section 8(d) of the National Trails System Act (16
- 5 U.S.C. 1247(d)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
- 6 lowing: "A railroad right-of-way may be designated for in-
- 7 terim use as a trail pursuant to this subsection or any
- 8 other provision of law only if such designation is approved

- 1 by the appropriate local governmental officials, as identi-
- 2 fied by the State in which the right-of-way is located.".
