A BILL

To direct the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to transfer certain parcels of land located in the counties of Greene and Calhoun, Illinois.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAND TRANSFERS BY DIRECTOR OF FEDERAL**
4 **EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY.**

5 (a) LAND TRANSFERS.—

6 (1) TRANSFER TO COUNTY OF GREENE, ILLI-
7 NOIS.—Subject to the requirements of this section,
8 the Director of the Federal Emergency Management
9 Agency shall transfer to the county of Greene, Illi-

nois, without consideration, all right, title, and interest of the United States in and to the lands described in subsection (c)(1), including all buildings and other improvements to such lands.

(2) TRANSFER TO VILLAGE OF HARDIN, ILLINOIS.—Subject to the requirements of this section, the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency shall transfer to the village of Hardin, Illinois, without consideration, all right, title, and interest of the United States in and to the lands described in subsection (c)(2), including all buildings and other improvements to such lands.

(b) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency may make a transfer under subsection (a) only if the county or village receiving the transfer enters into a written agreement with the Director to hold the United States harmless from all claims arising from or through the operation of the lands and improvements subject to the transfer.

(c) LAND DESCRIPTIONS.—

(1) LANDS IN COUNTY OF GREENE, ILLINOIS.—
The lands referred to in subsection (a)(1) are situated in the village of East Hardin, county of Greene, Illinois, and described as follows:

1 (A) Lot Numbered Four (4), as shown on
2 the Plat of East Hardin, according to the re-
3 corded plat thereof, in the office of the Reg-
4 istrar of Deeds of Greene County, Illinois, in
5 Plat Book B, on page 13.

6 (B) Part of Lot Numbered Nine (9) in the
7 Gulf, Mobile and Ohio Railroad Company's Plat
8 in East Hardin, according to the recorded plat
9 thereof, more particularly described as follows:
10 Commencing at the Northwest corner of Lot
11 Numbered Eight (8) of said Plat; thence East
12 320 feet along the North line of said Lot Eight
13 (8) and said North line as extended; thence
14 North 113 feet to the South line of Lot Num-
15 bered Four (4) of said Plat; thence West along
16 said South line to the Southwest corner of said
17 Lot Four (4); and thence South to the place of
18 beginning.

19 (2) LANDS IN COUNTY OF CALHOUN, ILLI-
20 NOIS.—The lands referred to in subsection (a)(2)
21 are Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Block 4 of the original
22 town of the village of Hardin, situated in the county
23 of Calhoun, Illinois.

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
