A BILL

To direct the Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to transfer certain parcels of land located in the counties of Greene and Calhoun, Illinois.

- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. LAND TRANSFERS BY DIRECTOR OF FEDERAL 4 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY. 5 (a) Land Transfers.—
- 6 (1) Transfer to county of greene, illi-7 NOIS.—Subject to the requirements of this section, 8 the Director of the Federal Emergency Management 9 Agency shall transfer to the county of Greene, Illi-

- nois, without consideration, all right, title, and interest of the United States in and to the lands described in subsection (c)(1), including all buildings
- 4 and other improvements to such lands.
- 5 (2) Transfer to Village of Hardin, Illi6 Nois.—Subject to the requirements of this section,
 7 the Director of the Federal Emergency Management
 8 Agency shall transfer to the village of Hardin, Illi9 nois, without consideration, all right, title, and inter10 est of the United States in and to the lands de11 scribed in subsection (c)(2), including all buildings
 12 and other improvements to such lands.
- 13 (b) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The Director of the 14 Federal Emergency Management Agency may make a 15 transfer under subsection (a) only if the county or village 16 receiving the transfer enters into a written agreement with 17 the Director to hold the United States harmless from all 18 claims arising from or through the operation of the lands 19 and improvements subject to the transfer.
- 20 (c) Land Descriptions.—
- 21 (1) Lands in county of Greene, illinois.—
 22 The lands referred to in subsection (a)(1) are situated in the village of East Hardin, county of Greene,
- 24 Illinois, and described as follows:

- (A) Lot Numbered Four (4), as shown on the Plat of East Hardin, according to the recorded plat thereof, in the office of the Registrar of Deeds of Greene County, Illinois, in Plat Book B, on page 13.
 - (B) Part of Lot Numbered Nine (9) in the Gulf, Mobile and Ohio Railroad Company's Plat in East Hardin, according to the recorded plat thereof, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of Lot Numbered Eight (8) of said Plat; thence East 320 feet along the North line of said Lot Eight (8) and said North line as extended; thence North 113 feet to the South line of Lot Numbered Four (4) of said Plat; thence West along said South line to the Southwest corner of said Lot Four (4); and thence South to the place of beginning.
- (2) Lands in county of calhoun, illinois.—The lands referred to in subsection (a)(2) are Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Block 4 of the original town of the village of Hardin, situated in the county of Calhoun, Illinois.
