A BILL

To provide assistance for low-income working families.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Family Investment
- 5 Package".
- 6 SEC. 2. ASSISTANCE FOR LOW-INCOME WORKING FAMILIES.
