Mr. Deutsch introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

# A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to make technical corrections to a map relating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE.
- 4 (a) FINDINGS.—The Congress finds the following:
- 5 (1) Coastal Barrier Resources System unit FL-
- 6 35P was designated by the Coastal Barrier Improve-
- 7 ment Act of 1990 (Public Law 101–591) to include
- 8 Florida State conservation land within the Coastal
- 9 Barrier Resources System.

- 1 (2) Unit FL-35P is an "otherwise protected 2 area", a designation that was intended to include 3 lands held for conservation purposes.
  - (3) The boundary of unit FL-35P runs through a portion of the Ocean Reef Harbor Course South development, which was in existence at the time of the 1990 Act.
  - (4) At the time unit FL-35P was designated, nine residences were located in the portion of that development that was included within the boundaries of the unit.
  - (5) The 11.7 acres comprising that portion are not held for conservation purposes, and are not an inholding within conservation lands.
  - (6) The United States Fish and Wildlife Service has received certificates of occupancy and corresponding plat maps from Monroe County, Florida, verifying that a portion of unit FL–35P was developed at the time and therefore the portion referred to in paragraph (5) was mistakenly included in the Coastal Barrier Resources System.
  - (7) Modification of the boundary of unit FL–35P to exclude the 11.7-acre parcel referred to in paragraph (5) would constitute a valid technical correction.

- 1 (b) Purpose.—The purpose of this Act is to make
- 2 a technical correction to unit FL-35P of the Coastal Bar-
- 3 rier Resources System to exclude from that unit the 11.7
- 4 acre parcel of developed property that was mistakenly in-
- 5 cluded in the unit.

### 6 SEC. 2. CORRECTIONS TO MAP.

- 7 (a) In General.—The Secretary of the Interior
- 8 shall, before the end of the 30-day period beginning on
- 9 the date of the enactment of this Act, make such correc-
- 10 tions to the map described in subsection (b) as are nec-
- 11 essary to ensure that depictions of areas on the map are
- 12 consistent with the depictions of areas appearing on the
- 13 map entitled "Amendments to the Coastal Barrier Re-
- 14 sources System", dated \_\_\_\_\_, and on file with the Sec-
- 15 retary.
- 16 (b) Map Described.—The map described in this
- 17 subsection is the map that—
- 18 (1) is included in a set of maps entitled "Coast-
- 19 al Barrier Resources System", dated October 24,
- 20 1990; and
- 21 (2) relates to unit FL-35P of the Coastal Bar-
- rier Resources System.

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
