A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to exempt orphan children from the immigration vaccination requirement.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXCEPTION FROM IMMIGRATION VACCINATION**

4 **REQUIREMENT FOR ORPHAN CHILDREN.**

5 Section 212(a)(1) of the Immigration and Nationality
6 Act (8 U.S.C. 1182(a)(1)) is amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (A)(ii), by inserting “ex-
8 cept as provided in subparagraph (C),” after “(ii),”
9 and

1 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
2 paragraph:

3 “(C) EXCEPTION FOR ORPHAN CHIL-
4 DREN.—Clause (ii) of subparagraph (A) shall
5 not apply to a child who is described in section
6 101(b)(1)(F) and is seeking an immigrant visa
7 as an immediate relative under section
8 201(b).”.
