## A BILL

To allow for a 1-year extension on conservation reserve program contracts expiring in 1997.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO OFFER ONE YEAR EXTENSION

OF CONSERVATION RESERVE PROGRAM CONTRACTS EXPIRING IN 1997.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any producer who currently has a contract granted under section

1231 of the Food Security Act of 1985 expiring in 1997

may request and shall receive a 1-year extension.
