To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to make permanent the religious worker visa program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Mother Teresa Religious
5 Worker Act of 1997”.

6 **SEC. 2. MAKING PERMANENT THE RELIGIOUS WORKER**
7 **VISA PROGRAM.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 101(a)(27)(C)(ii) of the
9 Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.

1 1101(a)(27)(C)(ii)) is amended by striking “before Octo-
2 ber 1, 1997,” each place it appears.

3 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
4 subsection (a) shall take effect on October 1, 1997.
