## A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of all right, title, and interest of the United States in a small parcel of real property included in the Cherokee National Forest in the State of Tennessee so as to provide clear title to the church occupying and using the property.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, CHEROKEE NATIONAL
- 4 FOREST, MONROE COUNTY, TENNESSEE.
- 5 (a) Conveyance Required.—The Secretary of Ag-
- 6 riculture shall convey, without reimbursement, to Millers
- 7 Chapel Church of Monroe County, Tennessee, all right,

- 1 title, and interest of the United States in and to a parcel
- 2 of real property consisting of approximately 5.5 acres,
- 3 which is occupied and used by Millers Chapel Church and
- 4 included within the boundaries of the Cherokee National
- 5 Forest in the State of Tennessee.
- 6 (b) Description of Property.—The exact acreage
- 7 and legal description of the real property to be conveyed
- 8 under subsection (a) shall be determined by a survey satis-
- 9 factory to the Secretary. The cost of the survey shall be
- 10 borne by the Secretary.
- 11 (c) Additional Terms and Conditions.—The
- 12 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
- 13 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection
- 14 (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the
- 15 interests of the United States.
