## A BILL

To prevent Members of Congress from receiving any automatic pay adjustment which might otherwise take effect in 1998.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. NO AUTOMATIC PAY ADJUSTMENT.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—The rate of pay for each office  
5       or position referred to in section 601(a)(1) of the Legisla-  
6       tive Reorganization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 31(1))—

7               (1) shall not be increased by reason of any ad-  
8       justment which, but for this section, would otherwise

1 take effect under section 601(a)(2) of such Act in  
2 1998; or

3 (2) if so increased before this Act becomes law,  
4 shall be restored, as of the date of enactment of this  
5 Act, to the rate of pay which was in effect for such  
6 office or position immediately before such date of en-  
7 actment.

8 (b) SPECIFIC REFERENCE REQUIREMENT.—Sub-  
9 section (a) shall not be superseded except by a provision  
10 of law that specifically repeals, modifies, or supersedes  
11 such subsection.
