## A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to limit the ability of hospitals to treat noncontiguous facilities as hospital outpatient departments.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Hospital Outpatient
- 5 Department Truth-in-Advertising Act of 1997".

1	SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON PAYMENT FOR HOSPITAL OUT-
2	PATIENT DEPARTMENT SERVICES FUR-
3	NISHED IN NONCONTIGUOUS FACILITIES.
4	(a) In General.—Section 1862(a) of the Social Se-
5	curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395y(a)), as amended by sections
6	4319(b), $4432(b)$ , $4507(a)(2)(B)$ , $4541(b)$ , and
7	$4603(c)(2)({\rm C})$ of the Balanced Budget Act of 1997 (Pub-
8	lic Law 105–33), is amended—
9	(1) by striking "or" at the end of paragraph
10	(20),
11	(2) by striking the period at the end of para-
12	graph (21) and inserting "; or", and
13	(3) by inserting after paragraph (21) the fol-
14	lowing new paragraph:
15	"(22) where such expenses are for hospital out-
16	patient services of a hospital furnished in a facility
17	unless the facility is located—
18	"(A) in the same building in which inpa-
19	tient hospital services are provided by the hos-
20	pital;
21	"(B) in a building that is located on land
22	contiguous (as defined by the Secretary) to a
23	building described in subparagraph (A);
24	"(C) in a building that was used for the
25	furnishing of hospital outpatient services by the
26	hospital as of September 25, 1997; or

1	"(D) in a building of an entity that, as of
2	such date, had entered into a binding contract
3	with the hospital under which the hospital will
4	provide services in such building.".
5	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
6	this section shall apply to services furnished on or after
