- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. EQUITABLE TREATMENT OF CLASS OF 1987 OF
- 4 THE UNIFORMED SERVICES UNIVERSITY OF
- 5 THE HEALTH SCIENCES.
- 6 An officer of the uniformed services who entered the
- 7 Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences as
- 8 a student in 1983 and who successfully completed the
- 9 course of instruction at the University in 1987 shall be

- 1 treated for purposes of determining pay and years of serv-
- 2 ice in the same manner as a student at the University
- 3 who graduated in 1986, notwithstanding the enactment of
- 4 the Defense Officer Personnel Management Act (Public

5 Law 96–513; 94 Stat. 2835).
