Mr. CUNNINGHAM introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To amend the Tariff Act of 1930 with respect to the marking of finished golf clubs and golf club components.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MARKING OF FINISHED GOLF CLUBS AND GOLF**

4 **CLUB COMPONENTS.**

5 Section 304 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C.
6 1304) is amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subsections (f) through (k)
8 as subsections (g) through (l), respectively; and

9 (2) by inserting after subsection (e) the follow-
10 ing new section:

1 “(f) MARKING OF FINISHED GOLF CLUBS AND GOLF
2 CLUB COMPONENTS.—The marking requirements of sub-
3 sections (a) and (b) shall not apply to—

4 “(1) golf club components that are imported for
5 processing into finished golf clubs in the United
6 States; and

7 “(2) golf clubs that are produced in the United
8 States.”.

9 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

10 The amendments made by section 1 apply to goods
11 entered, or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption,
12 on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
